

SPECIAL NOTICE: WORKING PAPERS FOR CITs and Staff Under 18 Years of Age

New York State Law requires that all employees not yet 18 years of age when employed (as of June 24, 2008), obtain Working Papers prior to starting their summer with us at camp. As our camp's CITs do some work as a part of their camp schedule during their stay at camp, it is expected that they will also have WORKING PAPERS while with us at camp.

For New York State residents, this is easily accomplished. Simply go to your High School Guidance Counselor and obtain them through his or her office. At the very least, your school's Guidance Office will have the information as to how Working Papers may be obtained.

If you live outside of New York State, you will be responsible for bringing along with you to camp the following items:

- (1) A copy of your birth certificate.
- (2) A letter from your High School on school stationery stating that you are in attendance at the school as well as stating your date of birth.
- (3) A letter from the CIT or Staff Member's parents, indicating that they give their permission for the CIT or Staff Member to work at camp.

For New York State residents, we must have these working papers into our camp office by June 1, 2008. For those CITs or Staff Members living outside of New York State, please make sure that you bring all of the above listed items with you to camp.
